About the Pledge To Measure

The Pledge to Measure, operated by Open Door Group, is dedicated to empowering organizations in Canada to create an accessible and inclusive workplace through a commitment to measuring disability inclusion.

By measuring and benchmarking disability disclosures, organizations create a culture of transparency and accountability. Through this commitment, businesses are not just ticking boxes — they are leading a transformative movement toward eliminating bias-based barriers and supporting a safe space where diversity thrives.

In its fifth year and first year as a national initiative, the Pledge to Measure has seen remarkable participation from 74 employers with workforce sizes ranging from 1 to 34,000 employees. These organizations represent industries from manufacturing to creative services to finance.

Participating employers see the profound value in surveying for disability inclusion and have made it a priority to engage in the Pledge to Measure annually.
